(b) in the case of the Income and Expenditure Account, of the excess of expenditure over income for the year ended on that date.

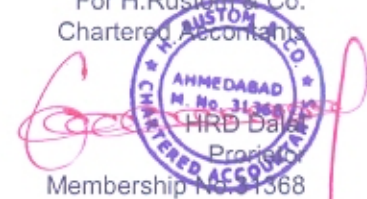
